### Other Charges – QSA Fee and Health Cover

A Queensland Studies Authority (QSA) fee of \$423.40 for Years 11 and 12 only and an annual Health Cover Premium of \$551 (rates vary for longer periods of cover) comprise other charges for a non-resident (overseas) student. Please note that these figures are subject to change and may vary each year in accordance with annual notification from the providers – Queensland Studies Authority and Medibank Private Health Insurance.

### Type of Account and Method of Payment

All fees are due and payable by the first day of Term 1 (23 January 2017). Payment options include BPAY, online payments, direct debit, cheque or credit card (Visa, Mastercard or Amex only). Note: Additional charges will apply to all credit card payments (Visa/Mastercard/Amex – 1.0%). There are no additional fees for payments made by direct debit (from cheque or savings accounts), BPAY, or cheque.

### School Council Policy

Fees are effective from 1 January of each year. The Council reserves the right to vary this schedule, upon notice to the fee payer. If an account is outstanding, a late payment charge of \$50 will be applied for the first instance 14 days after the due date, and every 30 days thereafter. Three months' notice of the student's withdrawal must be provided in writing as per the School's Enrolment Agreement (to avoid fees being charged in lieu of notice) except that notice must be received by the first day of Term 4 where changes are proposed from Term 1 in the following year.
